Library to Hold 2nd Annual Short Film Night

October 22, 2007 – The Stark County District Library will host its 2nd annual night of short films, **A Few Frames**, at the Cable Recital Hall at the Canton Cultural Center for the Arts on Saturday, October 27 at 7:00 pm.

The six films to be shown that evening include the 2006 Academy Award Winner for Best Live Action Short: “West Bank Story.” Also on the program will be “Lucky,” “Gopher Broke,” “Dear Sweet Emma,” “Spidermen,” and “11:59.” The films were chosen by popular vote of the attendees of the monthly Sandy Valley Independent Short Film Series which is held the first Wednesday of every month at the Stark County District Library’s Sandy Valley Branch.

About the Library:

The Stark County District Library is one of the best 100 libraries in the United States, ranked 6th in its population category. Its Main Library, 10 Branch Libraries, and two bookmobiles and two Kidmobiles serve 143,000 library card holders. More than 1.4 million people visited the Main Library or its Branches and Bookmobiles last year. Holdings number more than 925,000 items, and annual circulation is 3.8 million items. The collection includes books, audio visual materials, and periodicals for all ages. In addition, the Library provides programs and classes for adults, teens, and children, computer and Internet access, inter-library loans, reference and genealogy services, and traveling collections on two Bookmobiles and two Kidmobiles, as well as Outreach services to shut-ins, nursing homes, and housing units.
