Who we are:

The Stark County District Library Little Theatre Troupe is a children's performing group sponsored by the Stark County District Library. Youth ages 4 to the teen years participate in musicals and plays which are produced two to three times a year. Performances are held throughout the Stark County community and are free to the public. The "Friends of the Stark County District Library Little Theatre Troupe" was created to provide volunteer and financial support to the troupe as needed.

Purpose:

The purpose of the "Rising Star Scholarship Award" is to provide our young actors/actresses a \$250.00 award to be used toward their post secondary education.

This scholarship is an equal opportunity award. There will be no discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, national origin and ancestry.

Requirements and General Information:

1. The recipient must be a graduating high school senior who is enrolled in a post secondary educational program beginning in the fall after graduation.
2. The recipient must have a minimum of 2 (two) or more years of Little Theatre participation as a performer.
3. The recipients must have actively participated as a volunteer in other areas of the productions (sound, lights, backstage, costumes, makeup, music, scenery and assistant) after reaching age 14.
4. The recipients must have participated as a volunteer in other Little Theatre Troupe special programs such as Summer Workshops and special events promoting Little Theatre.
5. Applications may be obtained from the Friends of the Stark County

District Library Little Theatre Troupe or Carol Carmack, Director of Little Theatre.

6. All applications will be reviewed by the Board of the Friends of the Stark County District Library Little Theatre Troupe.
7. An interview by the Board of the Friends of the Stark County District Library Little Theatre Troupe may be given, if necessary, before a final decision is made.
8. The selected scholarship recipients will receive a \$250 check to be used for any expenses related to their post secondary education.
