Our staff provide personalized services for people who need individual help in specific areas, like navigating the Web, using their smartphones, finding jobs, getting passports, notarizing documents. In 2023, we helped 11,782 individuals.



Books by Mail

It's important to keep everyone connected – especially when the person is unable to leave their home. In 2023, we delivered 1,280 personalized packages to individuals who are homebound.

People booked our meeting and study rooms a total of **6,879 times**.
