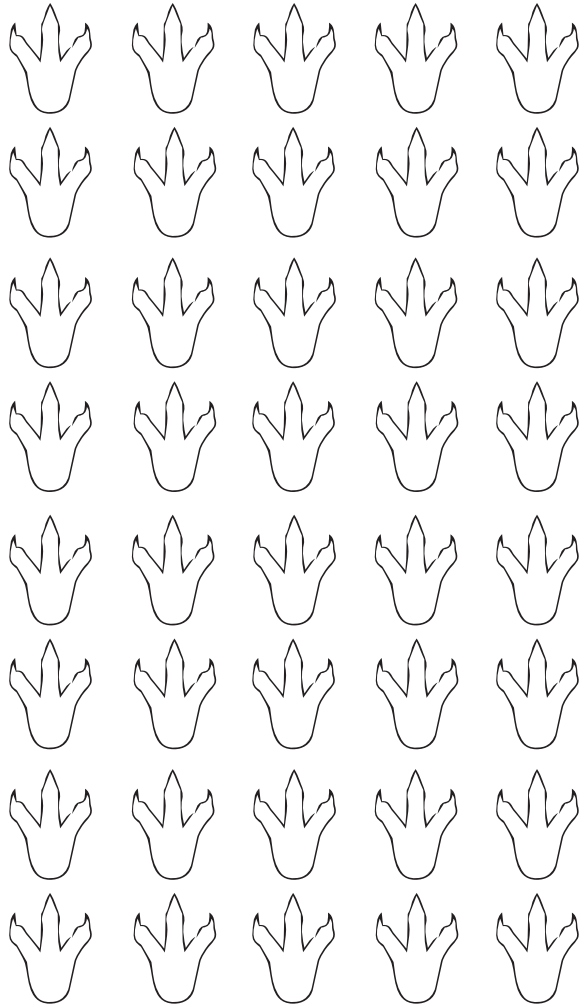

## Footprints and Fossils

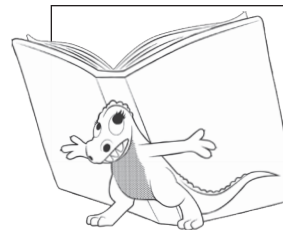
- Learn about photosynthesis by using three leaves in three different environments to explore the importance of light and water. \*
